Lent is a wonderful season to renew ourselves and to sacrifice.

Could you go meat-free for Lent? Reducing the impact of what we eat isn't simple. There are lots of factors in the environmental impact of our food: how far it has travelled, how and where it was produced, and the life-long impact of the product and packaging itself. Whilst certain foods might tread lightly on the planet in some aspects, they could have significant effects in others.

It is clear however that, in general, animal products – beef, dairy and sheep in particular – have a significantly larger environmental impact than those of plant based substitutes.

This Lent, making one big change to the way you eat could be an opportunity to think carefully about the environmental impact of your food. That's why we're inviting you to consider going without meat, or free of animal products all together, during the Lenten period. Start with giving up meat at least two or three times a week.
