FAITH PRIORITIES

There is a real struggle today to maintain our priorities, especially when it comes to faith.

Sunday Obligation: Absence from Eucharist is the first indicator that our priorities are misplaced. It is assumed here that people are absent by choice rather than requirements of work, sickness or other factors. Regular worship is needed for spiritual enrichment, hearing the Word and being in the community of Christians, to nurture our prayer life, and keep us on track. Christ is alive in Word and Sacrament. "Blessed are those who hear the Word of God and obey it." Luke 11:28. Jesus said, "Do this often in remembrance of Me."

The more frequently a person shares in the Lord's Supper, the less apt a person is to have faith failure. Here is the strengthening of faith, the assurance of forgiveness and the hope of eternal life. Remove it from one's life and there is a huge faith void. Christ is present in this sacred meal prepared for us!

It's easy for our faith life to be one of convenience. If I don't have something better to do. If I've gotten rested up from the hectic week I put in. If my kids don't have sports activities. There are all kinds of things that get in the way of a commitment to Christ, but faith is a matter of priority.

What are our priorities? The things that are most important to us will take priority in our lives. "One thing I ask of the Lord, this is what I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to gaze upon the beauty of the Lord and to seek Him in His temple." Psalm 27:4.

We are to love God and seek His kingdom. That is our highest priority. Over and over again in the scriptures we read that in order to be good husbands, wives, fathers, mothers, citizens, employees, employers, or leaders in any organization, our own relationship with God through Jesus Christ must have top priority in our lives. We cannot be any of those other things well if we aren't in a right relationship with Him. We may do well enough to get by, but not well enough to excel. That means we need to do what it takes to keep our relationship with Him strong. We spend time with Him in his Word and in prayer. We worship together with brothers and sisters in the faith.

Let us make "Faith" our top priority. God Bless.
