

He breathed on them, saying: "Receive the Holy Spirit." We discover that the Holy Spirit of God has a strong connection




with the forgiveness of sins. In John's Gospel this is the Pentecost experience when the Holy Spirit comes down on the disciples.

What Jesus does is reminiscent of the Creation story when God "breathed" over the waters and brought life and order into the chaos. Jesus "breathes" the Spirit of his Way, of his Truth and Life, making of them (in Paul's term) "new human beings", full of the Spirit of the Father and Jesus. The Holy Spirit, responsible for the forgiveness of sins, renews and recreates us, gives life to our dying souls soiled by sin whenever we approach "the laundry of the Holy Spirit", that is, the Sacrament of Confession.
