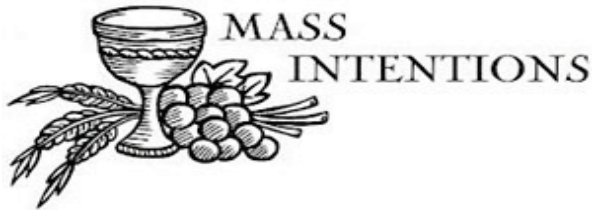
We can say of every child with joy and confidence, ‘praise to God’, echoing the prayer of John the Baptist’s father.
