Today's reading from St. Paul explains the "divine economy" of stewardship—"The relief of others ought not to impoverish you; there should be a certain equality. Your plenty at the present time should supply their need.



REFLECTION: The woman who in desperation believed if only she could touch Jesus she would be healed was right. Jesus saw her faith and freed her from her years of (in those days) shameful illness. Those of us who can no longer touch Jesus in the flesh have no less claim to His promise to heal us (perhaps in a different way than we expected) - but we need to believe, believe, believe, and trust in His promises!
