
Father, You revealed Your Son to the nations by the guidance of a star. Lead us to Your Glory in Heaven by the Light of Faith.

The star started them on the journey and then guided them to the end. Like our faith, the star which shone at our baptism is the promise of God to guide us through life. Faith grows


