Now the body is not a single part, but many.

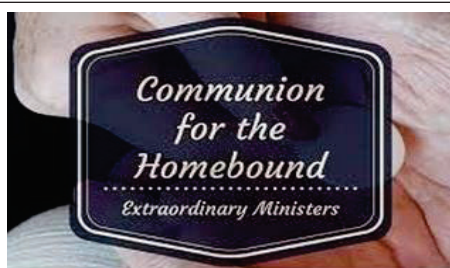
