Composting your leftover fruits, vegetables, grains, and non-animal proteins is the best way to



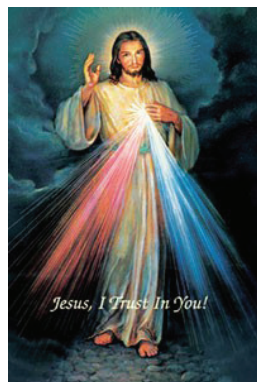
