#### **Inner Strength**

Inner strength comes from God. When you are stuck in your faith he gives you the strength to make spiritual progress.

When we draw strength from the indwelling Spirit, we find peace and confidence that exceed our own capabilities. We find compassion to love those who are otherwise unlovable. We find strength to serve, love, and sacrifice in ways that imitate Jesus himself. God Bless you.
