THE MOST HOLY BODY & BLOOD OF CHRIST: JUNE 11,2023



Live, Laugh, Love.



We hear these words often and see them carved out of blocks of wood in craft stores and written on picture frames to hang on

the wall. I often see them in houses as decals on the wall, but what does Jesus say about these three words? First let's take "LIVE" also translated "life". Put them together and we get, "live life". This immediately takes me to: John 10:10 The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have and enjoy life and have it in abundance. We hear this often, but stop and think about this. Our father sent us Jesus to teach us and show us His heart and will toward us. His will toward us is to "have and enjoy life, and have it in abundance (to the full, till it overflows)". So why would you settle for anything less than God's best for your life?

Now let's take "LOVE." This takes us to John 3:16. *God so loved the world!* "This is how much God loved the world: He gave his Son, his one and only Son. And this is why: so that no one need be destroyed; by believing in Him, anyone can have a whole and lasting life.

Do you see the circle of life as God offers it to us? It all comes back to accepting the gift of His son, Jesus, and trusting in Him and His provision for all good things for us, spiritually, physically, emotionally and financially.
