PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD : MARCH 24, 2024



From the Pastors 'Desk PALM SUNDAY: The Journey to the Cross

In Bethany, near the Mount of Olives, He told the disciples to get Him a donkey on which He would ride into

the city of Jerusalem. Jesus told the disciples to tell its owners, "The Lord has need of it" (Lk. 19:31). Jesus entered Jerusalem with His face set toward the cross knowing that He would be suffering a painful death as a sacrifice for our sin.

As Jesus drew near to the city of Jerusalem, the Bible says He wept. His tears were for the people who failed to recognize He was their Messiah. "As he approached Jerusalem and saw the city, he wept over it..." (Luke 19:41-42). As Zechariah had prophesied, the King would come humbly into Jerusalem riding on a donkey (Zechariah 9:9-10). In those days horses were used in battle and, according to historians, kings rode upon donkeys in missions of peace.

This Sunday we celebrate Palm Sunday. In the days following Palm Sunday, we journey with Jesus during his final days here on earth. we remember his passion, death, and resurrection. At the heart of our faith is God's commitment to us in sending his only son to die for us. God's passion is that we will be one with Him. Jesus enters into our history to show us what it really means to be human. So let us remember that though He once rode into the Holy City of Jerusalem on a donkey in humility, He is now seated at the right hand of the Father – ruling and reigning in glory as the GOOD and PERFECT King.

During this Holy Week, let us reflect on how strong is our faith in Jesus when we see him suffering under the weight of the Cross? Are we still willing to stand by him even when it seems impossible for him to get out of this situation,? Have we forgotten all the times we saw miracles happen and how God removed us from situations that could cause us harm? How often do we take the time to pray and thank Jesus for everything he does for us? When we pray, it means we're spending time with Jesus. St. Therese was someone who tried to make everything she did a prayer to God, even washing the dishes or doing the laundry. Jesus wants to be a part of your day wherever you are, and whatever you're doing. The next time you're doing your chores, just say a little prayer and ask Jesus to come and be with you. He wants to be part of everything you do. "The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Christ, and He shall reign forever and ever." Revelation 11:15b
