#### From the Pastors ' Desk

### Light of Risen Christ dispels darkness of Fear

As the Easter people we cannot allow the darkness of fear to overwhelm us rather we need the light of Easter to illuminate our lives and give us courage. Fears "must be brought to light. And when

fears, which are in darkness, come into the light, the truth bursts out. Do not be discouraged: If you are afraid, put it to the light and it will do you good!"

Although Jesus' resurrection "conquered the darkness of death," there are still dense clouds "that darken our time." We continue to experience a terrible war, while injustices and violence continue in many regions of the earth that destroy humankind and the planet. " Often it is innocent who pay the highest price: Not only is their existence compromised and made insecure, but their dreams for the future are trampled on. Many brothers and sisters are still waiting for the light of Easter."

When we reflect upon the Gospel reading from St. John, in which the risen Christ appears to his disciples while they were fishing on the Sea of Galilee, the disciples experienced moments in life that "put us to the test" and make us feel naked, helpless and alone experience. In those times of uncertainty, we must not keep to ourselves, because "fears must be said, fears must be expressed in order to be able to drive them away. Darkness puts us in crisis; but the problem lies in how we manage this crisis. "If I keep it only for myself, for my heart, and I don't talk about it with anyone, it doesn't work. In times of crisis, you have to talk, talk with the friend who can help, with your dad, your mom, your grandfather, your grandmother, with a person who can help. Crises must be illuminated to overcome them. Do not be afraid of life and all that it entails but instead to be afraid "of the death of the soul, of the death of the future, of the closure of the heart. Life is beautiful, life is meant to be lived and to give it to others; life is meant to be shared with others, not to close it in on itself.

**God loves us all** — **no matter how badly we have led our lives**. God wants us to recognize His mercy - which is greater than our sins. We can approach God with greater trust, receive His abundant mercy, and let it flow through us to others so that all will come to share His joy. *Have a Blessed Divine Mercy Sunday.*
