#### Mercy Triumphs over Judgement

God's mercy to us is seen in this: he stoops down to our misery and offers us compassion, understanding, healing and forgiveness.

The Mercy of the Confessional: God's mercy is very real and we are all called to

experience it firsthand. When we open our hearts with humility and transparency, we can contemplate God's mercy in a very concrete way. It is so wonderful to feel the merciful embrace of the Father in the Sacrament of Reconciliation, to discover that the confessional is a place of mercy, and to allow ourselves to be touched by the merciful love of the Lord who always forgives us!

Have you ever felt the gaze of everlasting love upon you, a gaze that looks beyond your sins, limitations, and failings, and continues to have faith in you and to look upon your life with hope? Do you realize how precious you are to God, who has given you everything out of love? St. Paul tells us that

As the saying goes: "When you get angry, you lose." Don't let your heart give in to anger and resentment. Happy are the merciful. Happy are those who know how to put themselves in someone else's shoes, those who are able to embrace, to forgive. We have all experienced this at one time or another. And how beautiful it is! It is like getting our lives back, getting a new chance.

Nothing is more beautiful than to have a new chance. It is as if life can start all over again.
