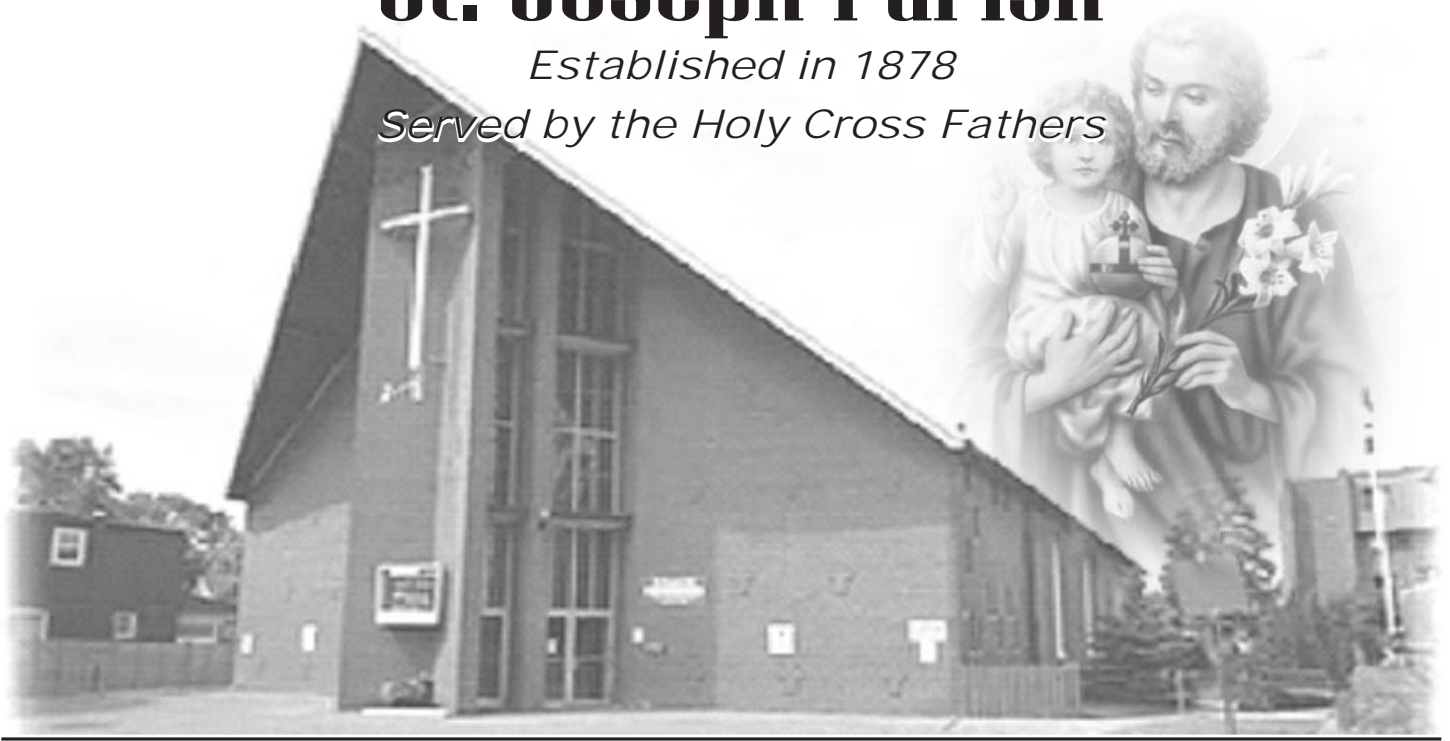

# THE MOST HOLY TRINITY : MAY 31, 2026



**The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity** invites us into the deepest mystery of the Christian faith: that God is one God in three divine Persons — Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. This is not simply a doctrine to be explained, but a mystery to be lived, prayed, and loved. Every time Catholics make the Sign of the Cross, we proclaim this truth: “In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.” The Trinity is at the center of our identity and relationship with God.

In the Gospel, Jesus reveals the Father’s love and promises the gift of the Holy Spirit. The Father creates us, the Son redeems us, and the Holy Spirit sanctifies us. Though each Person has a distinct role, they are perfectly united in love and purpose. The Trinity teaches us that God is not solitude but communion. Before the world began, there was already perfect love shared among the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. This mystery speaks directly to our human lives. Since we are created in the image of God, we are also made for relationship, unity, and love. In a world often marked by division, selfishness, and isolation, the Trinity becomes a model for how we are called to live. The Father gives Himself completely to the Son, the Son offers Himself fully to the Father, and the Holy Spirit is the bond of that eternal love. True love always moves outward; it seeks communion rather than self-interest.

The Trinity also reminds us that faith involves humility. Human language and understanding can never fully contain the greatness of God. Saints and theologians have reflected on the Trinity for centuries, yet it remains a sacred mystery beyond complete explanation. Rather than discouraging us, this should fill us with awe and trust. God is greater than our minds can grasp, yet He lovingly invites us into His divine life. Through Baptism, every Christian is welcomed into the life of the Trinity. We are not distant servants but beloved children of the Father, brothers and sisters in Christ, and temples of the Holy Spirit. Prayer itself becomes Trinitarian: we pray to the Father, through the Son, in the Holy Spirit. Every Mass reflects this divine communion and draws us deeper into God’s love.

The feast of the Most Holy Trinity challenges us to examine our relationships. Do we foster unity in our families, parishes, and communities? Do we reflect self-giving love, forgiveness, and compassion? The more we live in authentic love, the more we mirror the life of the Trinity. As we celebrate this solemnity, may we open our hearts more fully to the mystery of divine love and allow the Trinity to transform the way we live. **God Bless: Fr. Roshan Loy D’Souza, CSC.**

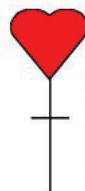
